Response to your information request - consent WGN200229 (36816) condition 22A

Thank you for your Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 request of 3 September 2024 asking questions related to this consent and discharges into the coastal marine area from Rukutane Point and Vella Street Pump Stations from 2 August 2024 to 3 September 2024.

Wellington Water Limited has not contacted the Manager Environmental Regulation, Greater Wellington Regional Council (GWRC) as required for consent WGN200229 (36816) condition 22A between 2 August 2024 and 3 September 2024.

However, GWRC contacted Wellington Water Limited on 26 August 2024 to report a perceived non-compliant discharge at the Rukutane Outfall believed to be discharging from the Porirua Wastewater Treatment Plant. An investigation was carried out and it was proven that a non-compliant discharge did not occur. The foamy/discoloration near the outfall was concluded to be generated from the inclement weather stirring up the seabed.

For your information I refer you to the <u>Porirua WWTP</u> website that provides a monthly status summary about the plant's performance.
