Development Impact levies

WCC currently Charge the development community the following;

Each 70m2 housing unit/home about \$3750 and multipoles of this for larger units/homes

Industrial Buildings \$75 per m2

Office buildings \$70-\$90per m2 (but this is always negotiated down?)

Our group is proposing;

A flat fee of \$25,000 per unit/ home

All commercial buildings \$150per m2

The conversion of office buildings to residential \$25,000 per additional toilet added to the structure (currently no charge) I am not going to make any friends in my development community?

The above figures will provide long term funding for City infrastructure, the city has not reviewed the residential levy for 15-20 years

Wellington Water provided a report to WCC in 2022 that was made public and talked about infrastructure cost in each suburb every time new units/homes are added
