WGN180065 non-notified resource consent application: Notice of decision

I am pleased to inform you that on 16 February 2018 your application related to the construction of the Ōmaroro Reservoir at Prince of Wales Park was granted to:

- Take and use groundwater for the purposes of dewatering excavations;
- Discharge stormwater runoff from areas of bulk earthworks and de-watered groundwater both treated with chemical flocculants, to land, the stormwater network or directly to water; and
- Undertake earthworks of an area of more than 3,000 m², including to excavate land that may intercept groundwater (bore).

I have enclosed a copy of the report outlining the reasons for this decision and the consent certificate¹. If you have any questions or concerns about any aspect of your consents, I would be happy to discuss them with you.

Consent term and conditions

Your consents expire on 16 February 2028. Please note that, under section 125 of the Resource Management Act 1991 your consents will lapse in ten years unless you begin to use them before then. It is important that you familiarise yourself with all of the conditions on your consents.

1. Consent processing charges

2. Annual consent monitoring charges

You will receive an annual consent monitoring charge each year on the anniversary date of when your consents were granted. There are three components to your consent monitoring charge:

- a. Your *customer service charge* is fixed at \$40 per year for each consent;
- b. Your *state of the environment (SoE) monitoring charge* is fixed at \$1,000.00 per year² which is relevant only for the discharge permit WGN180065 [35009]; and
- c. Your *compliance monitoring charge* will based on the actual and reasonable amount of time spent monitoring your resource consents.

The Resource Management Charging Policy is reviewed on an annual basis. As a result of this process the charges associated with the monitoring of your consents may alter.

² Your SoE monitoring charge is the full amount to be charged from 2017-18. Up until that time only a proportion of your SoE monitoring charge will be charged.
