Sorry about the delay getting back to you on your latest plans for Omāroro Reservoir.

These plans now cover two GWRC consents:

- 1. WGN180065 [35008] [35009] [35010] Principle consent for earthworks, dewatering and discharge treated sediment
- 2. WGN200317 [36864] Works associated with extending a stormwater pipe by 3m

Approvals:

- The amended Construction Environmental Management Plan (CEMP) Revision B submitted 23 February 2021, dated 22 January 2021 and associated appendices is **approved** under WGN180065 [35008] [35010] condition 7 and WGN200317 [36864] condition 4.
- The amended Erosion and Sediment Control Plan (ESCP) Revision B submitted 23 February 2021, dated 22 January 2021 and associated appendices is **approved** under WGN180065 [35008] [35009] [35010] condition 8 and WGN200317 [36864] condition 5.

GWRC Resource Advisor Emily McDowall (emily.mcdowall@gw.govt.nz 021-191-9689) is the compliance officer for WGN200317 [36864]. For simplicity I am happy to remain your initial GWRC contact for any compliance matters.

Emily is generally satisfied with your plans and just had the following comments –

- Please ensure all notifications associated with either WGN200317 [36864] are also submitted to notifications@gw.govt.nz
- This is optional as not a consent condition, but if your ecologist could send us records of any fish species observed and relocated through this fish rescue, ideally also the measurements of the fish, we can pass this on to our environmental science team as this data is helpful for them.
- The planting needs to take place during the planting season following the works, or at another timeframe which GWRC has agreed to (noting that this can't be postponed too long).
- Optional: the National Environmental Standards for Freshwater came into force in September 2020, after
 consent WGN200317 was granted (July 2020). The Freshwater NES requires councils to collect data about
 culverts. If the contractors were able to provide us with the attached information outlined that would be
 much appreciated e.g. by tracking comments in the document. This is not a consent requirement, just an
 optional extra.
