With dry weather ahead, river levels are still low. This makes the next few weeks critical for a smooth shift down to Level 1.

Keep up the good work - following Level 2 restrictions is the quickest way to get to Level 1.

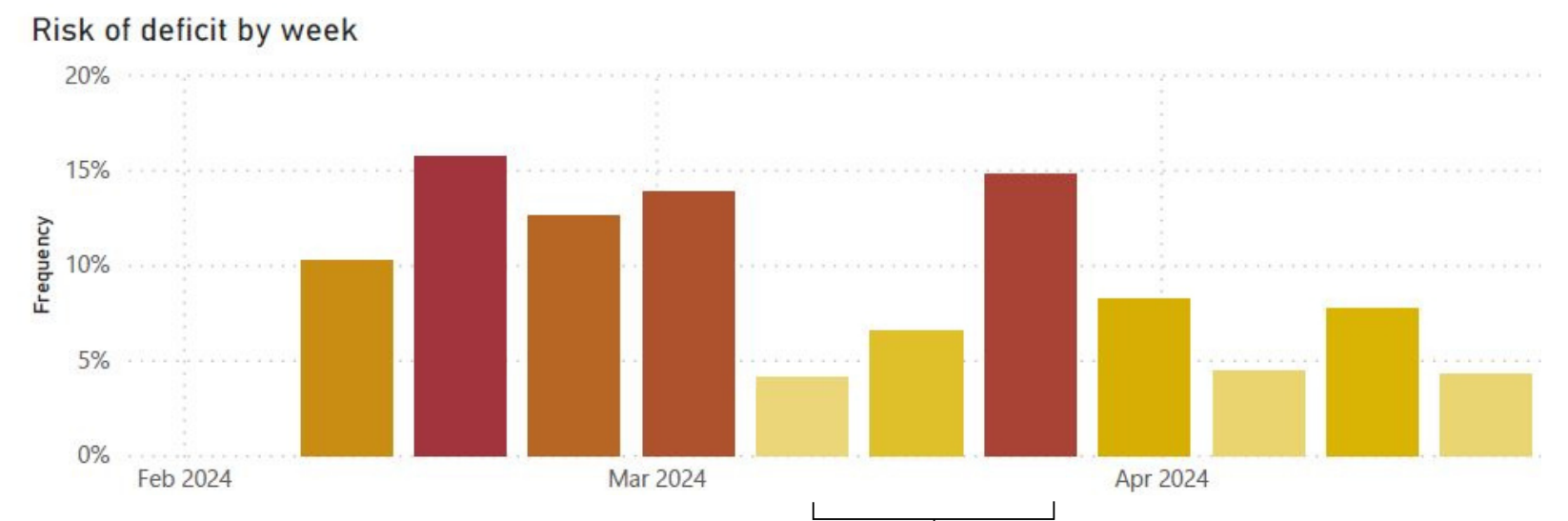

The risk of tighter water restrictions has reduced, but factors like low river levels mean that keeping demand steady is critical.

**The buffer is one key indicator of risk, and is offered as a guide only. Other factors are monitored as part of level risk assessment. The buffer is reviewed weekly.
