Faecal coliforms remain non-compliant for both the 90-day geomean and 80th percentile. Suspended solids and biochemical oxygen demand are compliant with consent parameters. There was one consented wet weather discharge to the Waiwhetū Stream in November.	No odour complaints in November.	Effluent Non-compliance: Several asset failures over the previous couple of months have negatively impacted the biological process however the team at the plant are urgently addressing these failures to restore effluent compliance. Community Odour Monitors: The community website platform, to see live odour readings, is now available on the Wellington Water website. Four of the five monitors are viewable with the final monitor awaiting installation.	What has been completed: - Final ducting connections arrived on site - First new milliscreen fan and first new biofilter fan have been installed - New milliscreen odour treatment system completed the first stage of commissioning testing. What's coming up: - Installation of the final community odour monitor to be completed - Complete second stage of testing for the new milliscreen odour treatment system - Install and commission second Milliscreen and Biofilter fans - Project completion	Non-compliant
