Conditions to Resource Consent WGN080003 [26182]

1. The location and nature of the occupation shall be in accordance with the consent application and its associated plans and documents lodged with the Wellington Regional Council on 2 July 2007, and additional information received on 26 October 2007.

For the avoidance of doubt, where information contained in the application is contrary to conditions of this permit, the conditions shall prevail.

Note: Any change from the location, design concepts and parameters, implementation and/or operation may require a new resource consent or a change of consent conditions pursuant to section 127 of the Resource Management Act 1991.

- 2. The submarine outfall pipeline structure shall remain the responsibility of the permit holder and be maintained so that:
 - a) Any erosion of the foreshore or seabed that is attributable to the submarine outfall pipeline is minimised;
 - b) The structural integrity of the pipeline remains sound; and
 - c) The pipeline does not pose a hazard to navigation.
 - d) Any maintenance that is identified as being necessary is undertaken within three months, or within such other timeframe as may be agreed by the Manager, Environmental Regulation, Wellington Regional Council following the submission of a programme of work to the Manager, Environmental Regulation, Wellington Regional Council.
- 3. The permit holder shall undertake an **annual physical assessment** of the condition of the outfall pipeline. This assessment shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
 - a) An assessment of the structural condition of the pipeline;
 - b) An inspection of the diffuser ports;
 - c) An assessment of the erosion or scour around exposed sections of the pipeline; and
 - d) Recommend any maintenance that is required.

The results of the assessment shall be submitted to the Manager, Environmental Regulation, Wellington Regional Council no later than three months after the assessment has been undertaken.
