### Official information request on Point Howard Slip.

Thank you for your official information request dated Saturday 25 March 2023.

You requested the following information:

- 1. A copy of all complaints, including the date each complaint was made, about a leak in the vicinity of Point Howard before the recent landslide caused the evacuation of homes there.
- 2. All internal and external correspondence at Wellington Water relating to the leak before the landslide happened.
- 3. All internal and external correspondence at Hutt City Council relating to the leak before the landslide happened.

We have considered your request in accordance with the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) and have decided to grant your request in part, by providing responses to questions 1 and 2. In making that decision it was necessary for us to consult Hutt City Council. This is because some of the information you requested was supplied by the Hutt City Council.

We transferred part of your request (the response to question 3) to Hutt City Council. The information to which that request relates, namely all internal and external correspondence at Hutt City Council relating to the leak before the landslide happened, was believed to be more closely connected with the functions of Hutt City Council. In these circumstances, we were required by <u>Section 12</u> of the Act to transfer your request.

Attached in our email to you is the information you asked for in question 1 and 2, which includes a print out of the service requests from our system which contains all correspondence sourced relating to the slip before the landslide happened.

Pursuant to <u>Section 7(2)(a)</u> of the Act, some information has been redacted as it is personal information about private individuals.

Thank you for your email summarising my verbal report of the roading problem near 78 Howard Road, Point Howard. The main issues are the settlement of the road surface, continuing damage to the roading pavement and the possible slipping of the downslope edge of the road (see attached Photos Nos 2 & 3). The downslope edge of the road comprises a shallow layer of fill material that has become saturated with water. There is some risk of a significant slip in this material that could damage the services in the road (sewer, water and fibre optic cable) and close the road. Some minor slipping has occurred at a distance of about 10 m below the road where some of the water from the leak is flowing out of the slope (see attached Photo No 1). Howard Road is the only road servicing many properties at the top of Point Howard and loss of this access would be very disruptive for these residents.

The water leak that has caused the damage to the pavement has been evident for at least three months and the flow has gradually increased until it is in excess of 100 litres per minute. It has previously been reported to Wellington Water who have inspected it but apparently have not given fixing it high priority (possibly because it is not visible from the road). If it continues the damage to the pavement and services could become costly to reinstate.

The water flowing from the leak has completely saturated an unoccupied private property at the base of the slope and flows down a usually dry stream bed into the harbour.
