Official information request for the measures at Wainuiomata and Waterloo water treatment plants, for the period of the last five, or preferably ten years.

I write regarding your official information request dated Tuesday 8 November 2022 for measurements of chemical concentration in the water supply and dates those were taken. You sent a follow up request on Monday 14 November 2022 asking which treatment plant (Wainuiomata and Waterloo) predominantly served Kelburn between a five-to-ten-year period.

We wish to assist you, but it would be very helpful if you were able to be more specific on the exact detail you wish to obtain and narrowing the timeframe. As stated, your question is very broad and will involve a considerable amount of collation. We would not be able to provide the data you request over a ten-year period without having to consider either declining on the grounds of [Section 17\(f\)](#) of the Act, or charging for the work involved. Are there specific chemicals you are seeking to identify? This information would assist us to narrow our search and provide you with meaningful data.
